

AUSTIN CITYCOUNCIL MINUTES

WORK SESSION MEETING TUESDAY, JANUARY31,2012

The City Council of Austin, Texas convened in a Special Called Meeting on Tuesday, January 31,2012, City Hallat 301 W. Second Street, Austin, Texas.

Mayor Leffingwell called the meeting to order at 9:05 a.m. Council Member Martinez was absent due to a family emergency.

COUNCIL ITEMS OF INTEREST

D.1 Presentation and discussion of the Austin Energy rate proposal, including the proposed changes to the rate structure, the rate review process, the Navigant Report, the rate case audit and the customer assistance program audit.

The briefing was done by Marc Ott, City Manager, and Larry Weiss, General Manager, and Elaine Hart, Senior Vice President of Finance, Austin Energy. The presentation was broken into two segments: the Navigant Report and Reserves and Financial Policies. Ken Mory, City Auditor, and Walt Persons, Assistant City Auditor, and Jawana "JJ" Gutierrez, Vice President of Customer Care, and Mark Dreyfus, Director, Regulatory and Government Affairs, Austin Energy did the briefing on the customer assistance program.

BRIEFINGS

B.1 Emergency Medical Services staffing configuration briefing.

This item was withdrawn without objection. The City Manager announced the information would be made available online.

The Mayor introduced the agenda for the February 2, 2012 Council meeting and allowed Council to give input or ask questions on any item posted on the agenda. Approve a resolution directing the City Manager to work with the Community Development Commission and representatives of community housing development corporations (CHDOs) and other eligible nonprofit organizations to implement a process for evaluation and consideration of CHDOs and other nonprofit organizations as community land trusts and report back to the Council on the status of

implementation of the process by April 5, 2012. (Notes: SPONSOR: Council Member Laura Morrison CO 1: Council Member Kathie Tovo CO 2: Council Member Chris Riley)

Purchasing

Authorize award, negotiation, and execution of a contract with SAIC ENERGY, ENVIRONMENTAL & INFRASTRUCTURE, LLC, Hendersonville, TN, KEMA, INC., and GOOD COMPANY ASSOCIATES, INC., or one of the other qualified offerors to RFP No. TVN0018, to provide electric vehicle infrastructure consulting services for Austin Energy in an amount not to exceed \$305,000 each and combined.

Mayor Pro Tem Cole adjourned the meeting at 12:00 Noon without objection.
