

Planning Commission Capital Improvement Program Committee APPROVED MINUTES Tuesday, June 14, 2011

The Planning Commission CIP Committee convened in a regular meeting on Tuesday, June 14, 2011 at 301 W. 2nd Street, City Hall, Room #3138, in Austin, Texas.

Commissioner Tina Bui's second on a vote of 4-0. The Plan will go before the full Planning Commission at its next meeting.
