Additional Backup Information	

This project is currently under construction and will mitigate frequent flooding problems in the Allandale area. The project area is bounded by Shoal Creek Boulevard on the south, White Horse Trail on the north, Burnet Road on the east and Shoal Creek on the west. Storm drain infrastructure is also being added on Nasco Drive north of White Horse Trail and on Rickey Drive west of Shoal Creek.

At the November 3, 2011 Council meeting, Council directed staff to explore means of accelerating completion of the project. One of the results of this directive was to revise the methods for reconstructing the streets in the project. The accelerated approach allowed reconstruction of Bull Creek Road to begin in February 2012. Change order #11 covers the cost of the acceleration and also includes the construction of approximately 1,000 linear feet of full-depth street reconstruction with new curb and gutter and driveways on White Horse Trail, and approximately 1,200 linear feet of milling and overlay from curb to curb on Nasco Drive. This additional work will provide a more complete final product for the community.

This project is located within zip code 78757 and is managed by the Public Works Department.
