Additional Backup Information

Austin Travis County Mental Health Mental Retardation Center d.b.a. "Austin Travis County Integral Care" (ATCIC), the state-designated mental health and mental retardation authority for Travis County, provides a wide range of development, educational and behavioral health services to the community.

The City's funding primarily serves as a grant match so that ATCIC can leverage state, federal, and other sources of funds for the provision of early childhood intervention services, homeless services, behavioral health services, and intellectual/developmental disability services to indigent residents of the Austin/Travis County.

The Interlocal Agreement also supports "Authority Services" at ATCIC, including but not limited to mental health disaster preparedness; prevention, education & awareness; community planning; and maintenance of infrastructure.
