Equal Employment Opportunity Policy

As the Vice President of Human Resources, I will also fulfill the role of Apple's EEO Officer. It is the responsibility of the EEO Officer to monitor Apple's Affirmative Action Program and to ensure Apple's continued commitment to equal employment opportunities, including Apple's policy prohibiting unlawful discrimination.

This is an ongoing policy and is in effect until further notice.
