Austin Energy's Energy Efficiency Services requests authorization to issue a rebate to CNC Investments Inc. in the amount not to exceed \$104,931 for performing duct diagnostics and improvements at Sunrise Bluffs Apartment Homes in accordance with the City of Austin's Multi-Family Rebate Program guidelines. This program is one element of Austin Energy's comprehensive Resource, Generation, Climate Protection Plan to 2020, approved in April 2010 by City Council, designed to reduce local air pollution through energy conservation, to reduce peak demand, and to assist customers in reducing electric consumption.							

In addition to the reduced air and toxic pollution, the project savings are also equivalent to an estimated 272,569 vehicle miles traveled, the removal of 23.3 cars from our roadways, or the planting of 3,119 trees or 156 acres of forest in Austin's parks.
