This hearing will consider a proposed ordinance that will reestablish local standards of care for the Parks and Recreation Department programs for elementary-aged youth.

Recommended by the Parks and Recreation Board.

The State of Texas Department of Protective and Regulatory Services administer state regulations and general licensing procedures for all child-care facilities. An exemption from licensing is available to the City in operating elementary-age recreation programs if the City annually adopts standards of care by ordinance after a public hearing and the standards of care are provided to parents of each program participant. The ordinance must include minimum staffing ratios, minimum staff qualifications, minimum facility, health and safety standards, and mechanisms for monitoring and enforcing the adopted local standards.

Additional Backup Information

This ordinance complies with this regulation. Adoption of the ordinance will result in appropriate standards of care applied to the City's recreation programs for youth.
