- 1. CALL TO ORDER: Commissioner Esparza called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m.
- 2. CITIZEN'S COMMUNICATION: None
- **3. PRESENTATION:** Jill Scott Stone of the Refugee Screening Health Clinic presented. A copy of the presentation is posted on the Boards and Commissions website. Questions followed.
- **4. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** The minutes from the regular meeting on January 11<sup>th</sup>, 2012 were approved on Commissioner Krupen's motion, Commissioner Ogunro's 2<sup>nd</sup>, on a 5-0 vote. Ancira and Kuhr absent.
- **5. REPORT: Immigrant Services Network:** Commissioner Esparza briefed the members on current activities. ISNA will have a forum with the candidates for Travis County Sheriff during its regular March meeting. The meeting will be held at the St. John's Community Center.
- 6. NEW BUSINESS:

A. Proposed Joint Hearing with Human Right's Commission regarding a resolution to remove Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) from the Travis County Jail

Tom Davis, Chairman of the Human Right's Commission and Esther Reyes, Executive Director of the Austin Immigrant Rights Coalition presented a draft joint resolution opposing Travis County's enrollment in the Safe Communities Program (SCOMM). Ms. Reyes made a brief presentation on SCOMM and its effects on the Austin immigrant community and law enforcement resources. The Commission approved the formation of a work group to review and revise the Resolution on Commissioner's Krupen's motion, Commissioner Hernandez's 2<sup>nd</sup> on a 6-0. Ancira not present.

The Commission approved oint meeting with the Human Right's Commission on March 26<sup>th</sup> at 5:30pm to tentatively agree on final language of the resolution on Commissioner Hernandez's motion, Commissioner Krupen's 2<sup>nd</sup> on a 6-0 vote. Ancira not present.

## 7. OLD BUSINESS:

## A. Emergency Contact Card for Residents with limited English proficiency.

Commissioner Hernandez presented the finalized cards. The Commission discussed a strategy for rolling out the cards, should approval be received from the Health and Human Services Department for printing. The plan is to present to the Human Right's Commission, the Public Safety Commission and having a press conference.
