#### **Ordinance Timeline**

April 11<sup>th</sup> – SWAC update

April – Finalize Ordinance language – Director & Law Office

May 9<sup>th</sup> – SWAC Action Item of proposed Ordinance

May 24<sup>th</sup> (or June 7<sup>th</sup>) – Council discussion and potential adoption

### **Intent of Ordinance Amendments**

- Provide enhanced enforcement against non-compliant haulers
- Support the reporting requirements of the Universal Recycling Ordinance
- Require documentation of a state annual safety inspection

# Issues of Concern – Working Toward Resolution

- Exemptions to Ordinance.
- Specify type of recycling information required to be submitted.
- Decal placement on vehicles and containers.
- Temporary decals for certain situations.
- Reduce reporting requirements from quarterly to bi-annual.
- New section referencing enforcement provisions. Article § 15-7.
- Appeal Processes.
- License Fees Staff engage in Cost-of-Service Study.

## **Education Implementation Elements (Code Compliance Responsibilities)**

- Web-site posting of licensed haulers
- Coordination with Development and Planning Office (building permits)
- Building and construction trade association presentations
- Public education, Hauler education, Builder education
- Pro-active field inspections

### **Enforcement Implementation Elements (Code Compliance Responsibilities)**

- Fee based fines for non-compliance
- Prohibition to haul within City if not licensed
- Complaint driven and investigative enforcement
- Construction building site inspections
- Process: Education/Compliance/Enforcement/Citations
