These additional grant funds bring the total grant amount to \$990,165.

ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: In March 2011, the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA) requested all community action agencies to put in place a contingency plan in anticipation of a possible 50% reduction in CSBG funding for 2012. The Health and Human Services Department (HHSD) received official notice from TDHCA in December 2011 that the department would receive level funding for 2012 and not a 50% reduction. CSBG level funding allows for the continued support of personnel who conduct CSBG activities/services.
