### ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

This contract is to provide the Austin Fire Department with an aircraft rescue and fire fighting vehicle (ARFF) that will be housed at the fire station located at Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (ABIA). This vehicle is intended to carry rescue and fire fighting equipment for the purpose of rescuing aircraft passengers, preventing aircraft fire loss, and combating fires in aircraft. This purchase is made in accordance with applicable requirements of the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 414, Standard for Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting Vehicles (2007 Edition), and AC 150/5110-10, Guide Specification for Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting (ARFF) Vehicles for airports classified as Index D airports.

Due to age and condition, this truck will replace an existing 1997 model aircraft rescue and fire fighting truck that exceeded the normal life expectancy. This unit has reached the eligibility criteria (13-15 years) for replacement according to National Fire Protection Association and FAA Advisory Circulars.
