

ORDINANCE NO. 20120412-025

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2011-2012 SCHEDULE OF FEES, FINES, AND OTHER CHARGES (ORDINANCE NO. 20110912-007) FOR THE RENAISSANCE MARKET VENDOR'S LICENSE FEES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Council finds that encouraging more diverse vendors at the Renaissance Market by revising the fee schedule will appeal to a broader customer base which is in the interest of the community, thereby a public purpose.
