Intent of Ordinance Amendments

- Provide more clarity on services provided through revenues collected by this fee
- Rename the fund to better describe to residents the provided services
- Delineate more clearly the funding directed to Austin Resource Recovery and Code Compliance

Purpose of Fee

City services funded through the Clean Community Fee provides litter and nuisance abatement, street cleaning, household hazardous collection, and services provided by the City under the Universal Recycling Ordinance.
