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***Ordinance Timeline***

April 11<sup>th</sup> – ZWAC Commission update  
May 6<sup>th</sup> – Final ZWAC Hauler Subcommittee Meeting  
May 8<sup>th</sup> – ZWAC Commission Report and Recommendation  
May 24<sup>th</sup> – Council discussion / request for adoption  
July 1<sup>st</sup> – Implementation begins

***Intent of Ordinance Amendments***

- Provide enhanced enforcement against non-compliant haulers
- Support the reporting requirements of the Universal Recycling Ordinance
- Require documentation of a state annual safety inspection

***Major Amendments Notations***

§ 15-6-44: Specify type of information required to be submitted.  
§ 15-6-51: New requirement for documentation of annual state inspection of vehicles.  
§ 15-6-52: Hauler reporting requirements defined.  
§ 15-6-54: Decal placement changed to side of door.  
§ 15-6-56: Reduced reporting requirements from quarterly to semi-annual.  
§ 15-6-59: Section referencing enforcement provisions.  
§ 15-7: Article on enforcement procedures.

***Education/ Compliance/ Enforcement/Citations Implementation Elements***

- Web-site posting of licensed haulers
  - Coordination with Development and Planning Office
  - Building and construction trade association presentations
  - Public education, Hauler education, Builder education
  - Pro-active field inspections and Complaint driven and investigative enforcement
  - Fee based fines for non-compliance - Prohibition to haul within City if not licensed
- All activities performed by Code Enforcement staff – Licensing/Education/Compliance/Enforcement

***Proposed FY13 Fees***

\$100/vehicle per year and \$9/container per quarter

***Cost of Service Study***
