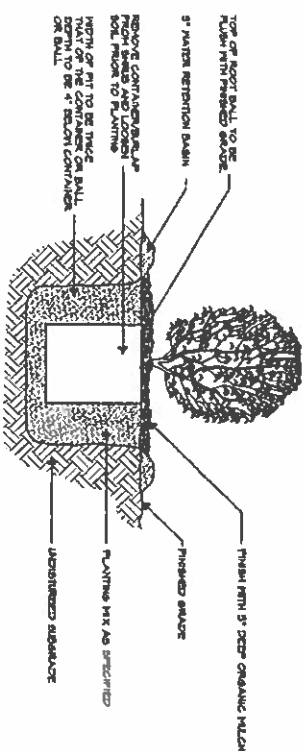
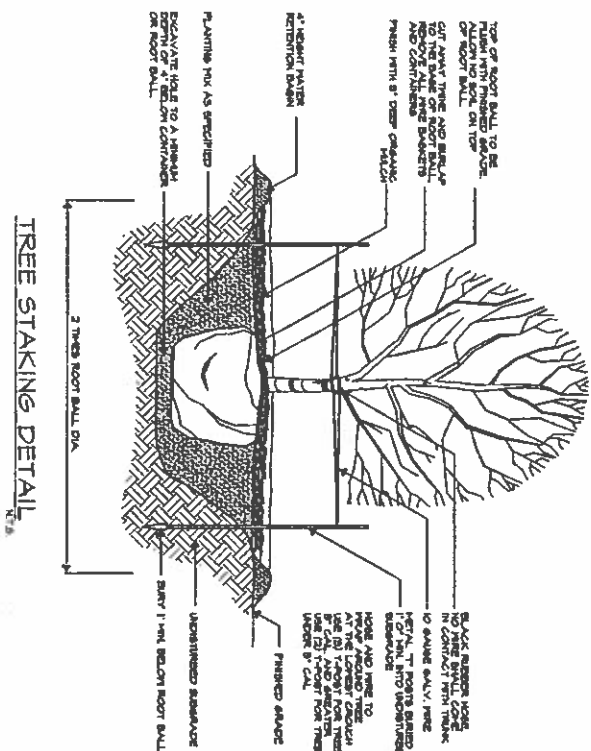

- GENERAL LANDSCAPE NOTING:
1. All proposed landscaping is to be installed on per lot/lot 4/6g and existing conditions.
2. Existing trees to be located shall be protected by tree protective fencing and/or construction signage (NOTES TO CIVIL, PLANS AND DETAILS). No trees shall be removed or damaged during construction. The contractor shall be responsible for the protection and complete removal of the tree or clusters of trees. No tree or clearing of equipment shall be allowed in these areas.
3. Large open spaces will be landscaped with grass to be installed prior to planting. Large open spaces will have spray or vacuum nozzles, apply that across the lot to create a low level of seeding trees shall be noted like.
4. All landscaping, replacement, watering, during trees grow, and all other responsibilities shall be maintained and replaced as required to meet contractor requirements.
5. Landscaping to be maintained and replaced as required to meet contractor requirements.
6. Other major scenic easement obligations of adjacent trees for these species when on the landscape plan are beyond. Additionally, the owner may wish to provide final material above and beyond the materials shown on the plan.
7. All or some of nature vegetation beyond the limits of construction shall be left undisturbed.
8. All proposed trees shown on the plan are for landscape requirements and replacement trees. Replacement trees shall be substituted on plan by (R) placed next to the tree, canopy, or plant listed. All replacement trees shall be irrigated by an automatic watering system to be installed prior to planting.
9. Landscaping will be protected by concrete edging, curb edges or equivalent barriers to maintain the area.
10. All required landscape planting areas shall be a minimum of 6' back in width (feet) or width. Large parking lots shall have medians with a 10 foot minimum (feet) and.
11. All plant materials and irrigation shall be in place and operational at the time of construction. The contractor shall be responsible for the maintenance and watering of the plants until the project is completed and the plants are established.
12. No more than 20% of the proposed plant material shall be lost the same species or species.
13. The owner will substantially maintain the required landscaping in accordance with the Land Development Code Section 25-01 in effect at the time of the plan approval.
