STAFF CONDITIONS:

1. Removal of all development from within the Critical Water Quality Zone (CWQZ) with the exception of the outfall for the Water Quality detention pond.

- 2. Permanent demolition of approximately 0.52 acres (22,800 square feet) of impervious cover from within Water Quality Transition Zone and revegetate with COA specification 604S.
- 3. Revegatation of entire disturbed current CWQZ with COA specification 609S.
- 4. Provide landscaping per ECM section 2 using plants from the COA GrowGreen guide;
- 5. Implementation of an Intergrated Pest Management Plan.

RATIONALE

Findings of fact have been met. The applicant will remove over ½ acre of impervious cover from within the Water Quality Transition Zone, and revegetated with City of Austin Specifications 604S.. The site will have water quality ponds and treat runoff from the site.
