Prior Council Action:	June 23, 2011: Council approved Resolution No. 20110623-096 directing the City Manager to adopt the Animal Advisory Commission's recommended criteria in the selection process for a non-profit that will operate the Adoption Center at the current Town Lake Animal Center site. November 10, 2011: Council conducted a public hearing and approved Resolution No. 20111110-106 authorizing the use of the Town Lake Animal Center site for animal adoption purposes for a period not to exceed 18 months. Council approved Ordinance No. 20111110-022 authorizing the City Manager to execute a temporary license agreement with Austin Pets Alive permitting them to temporarily occupy and operate the town Lake Animal Center. April 26, 2012: Council conducted a public hearing and approved Resolution No. 20120426-135 authorizing the amendment to the temporary license agreement. Council also approved an item authorizing negotiation of the amendment.
