Subject

Authorize award and execution of a 36-month requirements supply contract with COVERT FORD LINCOLN, or one of the other qualified bidders for IFB-BV SSC0084, to provide parts for medium and heavy duty Ford trucks for the Fleet Services Department in an amount not to exceed \$393,120 with three 12-month extension options in estimated amounts not to exceed \$186,624 for the first extension option, \$223,949 for the second extension option, and \$268,739 for the third extension option, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$1,072,243.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$36,000 is available in the Fiscal Year 2011-2012 Operating Budget of the Fleet Services Department. Funding for the remaining thirty-two months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

If the City is unsuccessful in negotiating a satisfactory agreement with the selected offeror, negotiations will cease with that provider. Staff will return to Council so that Council may select the other qualified offeror and authorize contract negotiations with this provider.
