Lucy's was granted a permit based on bands playing at 70 decibels or below. They far exceeded that from March 14-18th. Lucy's is located directly behind our house. Our bedroom is feet from the bandstand. As the photos show, they blasted the neighborhood with microphones, amplifiers, subwoofers and speakers. They encouraged people to park in our neighborhood on Facebook because they used the spaces for seating. I am recovering from breast cancer. I had many (Attach additional page if necessary.) surgeries last year with major complications, many treatments and lots of trauma. The most important things for my recovery are sleep and lack of stress. An outdoor music permit will deny us any enjoyment of our property. We cannot sleep, watch TV, enjoy dinner with friends, or spend

neighborhood. We are huge fans of local food and music. However, it seems completely unfair for a business to move into a residential neighborhood, and blast the neighborhood for days on end and totally end our peace and quiet as a sweet peaceful street. We purchased this property because it was on a sweet quiet street that ends in St. Ignatius Catholic Church. This permit will ruin the peace and quiet of our precious neighborhood. My health and peace of mind cannot take this horrible intrusion into our lives. They clearly proved that they will not ~~even~~ abide by the permit they applied for. We are so disappointed that they have turned out to be a bad neighbor.
