- 2. Follow up on request from Coordinating Committee for data from Morrison et al GCWA Abundance study Willy Conrad gave a verbal report on the Coordinating Committee's request. He also reported that Morrison's study had been published in the Journal or Wildlife Management. Chair steed requested a copy Kevin Connolly offered to forward a copy to members though the secretary. Following discussion members agreed that the SAC should review the publication, the submitted report and data, and offer a recommendation to the Coordinating committee about the study's applicability to BCP. No action was taken.
