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Dear Board Members:

I am concerned with some inaccuracies and misrepresentations of circumstances seeing some of what is being scanned in backup. I especially object to the characterization of events in Ms. Prairies letter to the board. There has been a great deal of confusion and difficulty from obtaining information regarding the permit, application information, to proper forms and procedure related to appeal, logistics and dates. I can support this. We did meet with staff to try and clarify information and details regarding the permit as well regarding procedure on April 23rd. It was not at all a clear process. There was a lot of runaround, inconsistent message and instructions changed. Time was lost to this but not the tactics that are portrayed in this letter. I did not hear anything from the City for over 3 weeks after this. The process we were told was to first take place before any moves to BOA had yet to occur, with information continuing to change when I learned this hearing had been scheduled. I had not even been notified. This was not about multiple extensions or ploys but about a due process still unfolding. I am also concerned with changing information and deadlines and other representations regarding process and procedure. But must completely disagree with Ms. Prairie's contentions and go on record as I take exception to this inaccurate portrayal of circumstances as she has presented them.

Please allow me the opportunity to further provide additional information to better clarify at a later date. I wanted to at least offer some response before this backup was due.
