- Agreement does not provide exclusivity to athletic sports fields and sports complexes
- All other dates and times not reserved through this process, the subject field(s) referenced in III A. remains open to the public

# PARTNERSHIP STANDARDS ATHLETIC FIELDS

#### Current:

- Maintain the subject fields in a good and functioning condition, keeping the field safe for youth recreation
- Provide general maintenance, litter, and clean-up for the subject fields

- YSO's must comply with the City of Austin's Park Maintenance Operations Manual
- YSO's must comply with the City of Austin's Integrated
   Pest Management Program

## PARTNERSHIP STANDARDS

## CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECKS

#### Current:

• Must conduct annual background checks on all volunteers or paid employees who will interact with youth

- Must conduct criminal background checks on any person holding a position within the organization
- Sole responsibility of the YSO to conduct all CBIs
- City of Austin's Criteria for CBI review as the general guidelines
