


# **Foundation Communities:**

- **17 properties** with **2,553 units** (1,862 units in Austin)






- Model is Housing +Services

# **SROs/Permanent Supportive Housing:**

- 4 "Terrace" properties with **465 units**
- Extensive mental health, substance abuse and other services funded by SAMHSA and others
- Numerous partnerships for services
- Low-barrier; not no-barrier
- Seek **diversity of resident** employment status, need level, etc.



- We must be a **good neighbor**
- Property operations should be self-sufficient


## Partnership Housing Program at Spring Terrace:

•83% of applicants approved for housing (10 of 12)

- •4 applicants who appealed were successful, 2 were unsuccessful
- 9 participants currently living at Spring Terrace

   01 is currently incarcerated
   01 has been issued Notice to Vacate
   Others doing okay

In general, case management and communication have been strong
