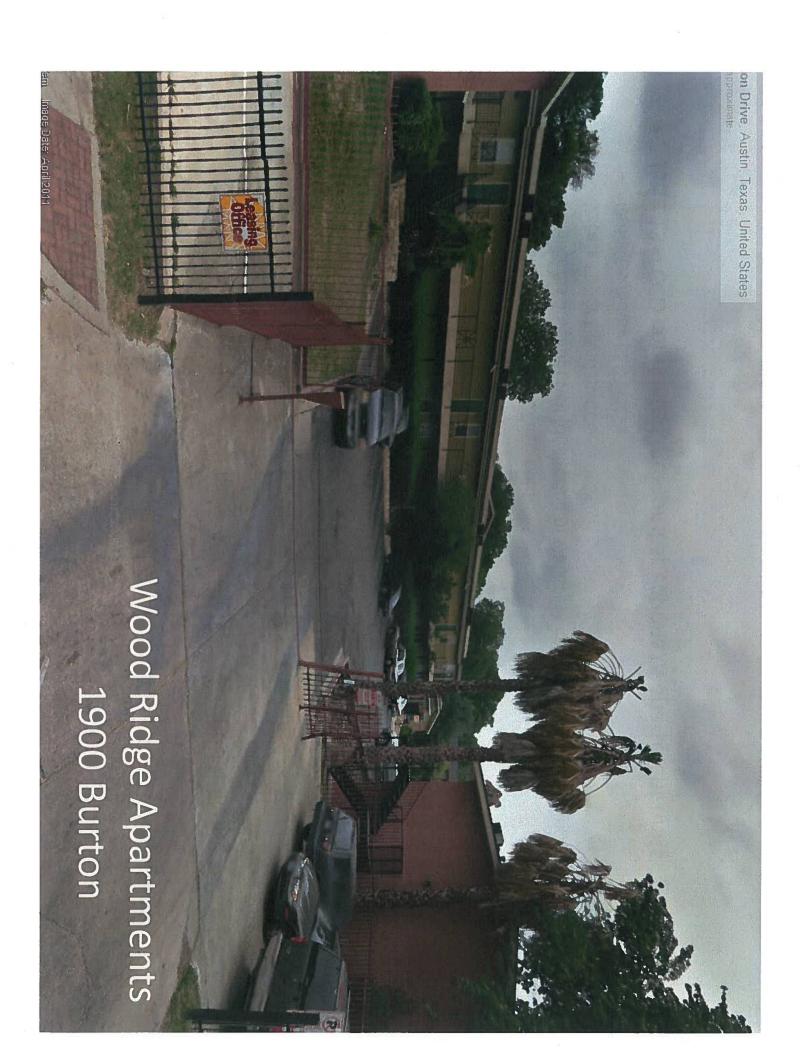

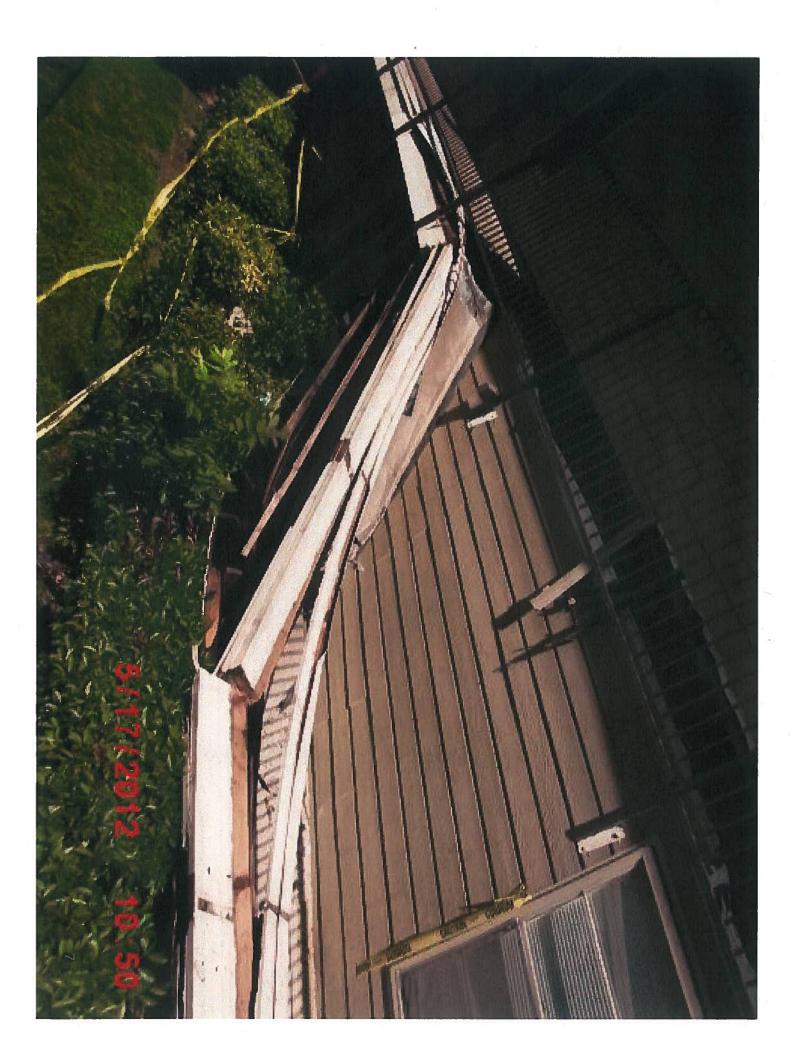
Background

May 16 – June 14, 2012

- danger created by the separation of upper walkway from building May 16 - CCD received a call from AFD — AFD evacuated building 2 due to
- building 2 collapsed other elevated walkways were in dangerous conditions. Walkway from May 17 – CCD, PDR and AFD inspected 14 other buildings and found 5
- walkways on five buildings and vacate order on same five buildings and 30 May 18 – CCD directed property management to temporarily shore up Citations were issued
- June 4:
- Special called meeting of BSC held
- All permits and approval for shoring of walkways completed for 5 buildings
- Vacate Order Lifted by CCD
- Order issued by BSC
- June 13 CCD conducted interior inspections of apartment units

BSC Order

- All necessary permits be secured
- Repairs on upper walkways for buildings 3, 9, 10, 11, and 13 be completed in 75 days (Starts June 9 and ends August 23, 2012)
- All repairs, modifications shall meet IPMC
- Engineer's reports/certifications shall be submitted to City within 75
- Owner or owner's representative shall request inspections to verify compliance
- assessed until work is completed and inspections passed After 75 days a penalty of \$1,000 per week per building (15 total)
- Monthly progress report by local representative at each BSC:
- Schedule of repairs
- Listing of repairs completed
- Listing of repairs to be completed
- Estimated completion date for repairs
- Next BSC scheduled for June 27, 2012

Residents' Status

- 48 families were originally displaced (occupying buildings 2, 3, 9, 10, 11 and 13)
- CCD partnered with other City departments and local non-profit organizations to offer available resources
- Two community information session were held
- Martin Middle School May 24
- Montopolis Recreation Center May 29 2012
- All but 9 Families found temporary housing
- On May 24, 2012 the City offered temporary emergency housing to the 9 families at the Staybridge Suites
- All families are checked out of hotel by Friday June 15, 2012
- Most of the impacted residents received \$500 check from property management and in doing so signed a lease termination
- were pro-rated residents were terminated and security deposits were refunded and rents CCD was informed by Asset Plus Properties that all leases of impacted

Apartment Unit Inspections Results of Interior

- Conducted on June 13, 2012
- Set up on-site office (11:00 am 3:30 pm)
- 30 CCD Inspectors
- 84 out of 134 units were inspected (occupied units were inspected with consent of tenant)
- Onsite education resources available
- CCD identified 760 deficiencies
- No additional vacate orders were required

- bring all elevated walkways into compliance Apartment owner has 75 days to meet the BSC order and
- CCD assigned one inspector to monitor progress at the site (75 days)
- progress reports (next BSC is June 27th) BSC meeting during the 75 day compliance period to provide Apartment owner representative is scheduled to attend each
- CCD will be working with the property owner and on-site during the June 13th inspections representative to address the 760 deficiencies identified
- If reasonable progress is not made by the property owner, CCD staff will bring the matter before a future BSC Meeting
