






#### **City of Austin Government Operations Consumption**

## **SharePoint Data Analysis**



- 1,980 total actions
  - Known status of 750 actions
    - 208 completed
    - 365 in progress
    - 176 not-started, deferred, or on-hold
  - Known GHG reduction type of 513 actions
    - 214 conceptual / unquantifiable
    - 167 indirect
    - 132 direct
