






City of Austin Emissions




Regulated & Non-Regulated Greenhouse Gas Emissions 5,930,274 MTCO2e **CY 2011**



Emissions Over Time










Energy Usage

Renewable Energy


- 100% renewable energy to power all City-owned buildings and facilities
- 122 kW of new Solar PV on City-owned facilities 206,056 kWh annually

Building Efficiency

- Interior Lighting: 385.85 kW, 1,723,386 kWh, \$140,163 savings annually
- Exterior Lighting: One Texas Center Parking Garage savings of 27.8 kW,
 243,492 kWh, and \$20,696 annually
- Technicenter upgrades 71,054 ccf, 257,000 kWh, and \$70,995 annually
- In-house building re-commissioning program 8 major facilities plus others
- 100% (25 / 25) City of Austin building ECAD compliance

Cost / Benefit Analysis

- Life Cycle Cost / Environmental Analysis on all vehicle packages
- 65% of Vehicles are Alt Fuel or Hybrid (up from 60%)
- 263 Hybrids (5% of total vehicles)

Fuels

- Alternative Fuel = 65% of total (up from 48%)
 - Diesel use almost 0, B20 usage is up 80%
 - Unleaded use is down 30%
 - E85 usage up over 100% from last year
- Citywide mpg flat at 11.5 mpg
- Training Program for all vehicle operators


