

The Austin Chamber, through investment from Opportunity Austin, funded:

- Multi-strategy regional effort which ensured Metro Austin higher education enrollment increased by 21,000 students over the 2005 baseline of 67,000.
- College/Career Awareness: Skillpoint Alliance to conduct its College & Career Expo for 3,000 area high school students annually to inform them of mixed skill-level occupational opportunities, including high demand technology jobs.
- College Financial Aid: Coordinated several dozen annual college financial aid completion events, increasing the FAFSA submissions by 108% to 11,000 since 2005 with net financial impact of \$101 million.
- College/Career Readiness: Austin Partners in Education to increase the Austin ISD college readiness rate by 7.5% for the Class of 2011, compared to the previous year's graduating class; Round Rock ISD to increase Round Rock High School college readiness numbers by 150 annually.
- College Certificate/Degree Completion: Secured commitment from Austin Community College to increase certification and degree completions to meet 90% of relevant local workforce demand in information technology and allied health.



Education & Workforce Development Austin

- Due to OA funding, the Chamber & 15 area school districts set a 70% direct-tocollege enrollment goal for the Class of 2015, up from 62% for the Class of 2010.
- The region's first college enrollment initiative exceeded its first 5-year goal to increase college enrollment from our region by 30% between 2006 & 2010.
- The region's Skillpoint College/Career Expo exposed 13,000 H.S. students to Austin careers & the post-secondary education they require.
- Financial Aid Saturday events in 2011 helped 2,000 families submit federal financial aid forms—FAFSA filings increased 102% since 2006 and Class of 2011 financial aid is up \$50M over Class of 2006.
- Austin ISD's college/career readiness rate increased from 38% to 55% between 2008 & 2010.
- Sophisticated Central Texas Student Futures Project database tracks individual H.S., employment, military & post-secondary education data records.
- Chamber partnerships issued progress reports for 11 ISDs addressing direct college enrollment, college readiness, H.S. graduation & TAKS pass rates, as well as one for Austin Community College detailing accomplishments, identifying areas for growth, & addressing talent development needs specific to industries in Austin.

Best Performing 2009-2012 Among the Top 50 Metro Areas


