

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 20120412-021, RELATING TO PEDICABS, BY EXTENDING THE MORATORIUM ON NEW PEDICAB PERMITS UNTIL APRIL 23, 2014, AND AMENDING CITY CODE SECTION 13-2-275 REGARDING PEDICAB INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Part 8 of Ordinance number 20120412-021, is amended to read:

~~[For a period of six months from the effective date of this ordinance, n]~~ No new pedicabs will be permitted until April 23, 2014; those currently permitted may remain in operation, subject to continued evaluation by the Austin Transportation Department. If a pedicab is damaged irreparably during this period its permit may be applied to a new tricycle-type pedicab, but not a new trailer-type pedicab. ~~[Upon the expiration of the six month period,]~~ After April 23, 2014, a cap on total permits for pedicabs shall be considered.

PART 2. City Code Section 13-2-275 (*Non-Motorized Service Inspection Requirements*) is amended to add Subsection (D) to read:

§ 13-2-275 NON-MOTORIZED SERVICE INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS.

(D) After July 1, 2013, a tow-bike used with a trailer-type pedicab must pass an annual safety inspection from a third-party provider approved by the Department.
