BRIEF EXPLANATION OF PROPOSED RULE

The rule establishes the hours of splash pad operation during Drought Response Stage 3

TEXT OF PROPOSED RULE

A. During Water Conservation Stage 3 Regulations, all splash pads utilizing Austin Water Utility potable water may only spray water between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

AUTHORITY FOR ADOPTION OF PROPOSED RULE

The authority and procedure for adoption of a rule to assist in the implementation, administration, or enforcement of a provision of the City Code is provided in Chapter 1-2 of the City Code. The authority to regulate the water use is established in Texas Local Government Code Section 552.001 and Title 6 of Austin City Code.
