# BRIEF EXPLANATION OF PROPOSED RULE

In accordance with Austin City Code Chapter 6-4-2(4) AWU Authorized Irrigation Inspector status may be awarded to an Irrigation Inspector licensed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality who has in addition passed a director-approved class in landscape irrigation. This rule establishes the method for asserting and maintaining AWU Authorized Irrigation Inspector status.

### TEXT OF PROPOSED RULE

at a cost of ten cents per page:

- (A) A person seeking AWU Authorized Irrigation Inspector status shall:
  - 1. Provide documentation to Austin Water Utility of a valid Irrigation Inspector license granted by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
  - 2. Provide documentation of successful completion of the AWU Director-approved landscape irrigation course within the preceding six (6) months.
  - 3. Submit an application for AWU Authorized Irrigation Inspector status on forms provided by Austin Water.
- (B) The Director or his designee shall grant or deny in writing any written request to assert AWU Authorized Irrigation Inspector Status within 10 working days after receipt of a complete application.
- (C) The Director or his designee may deny a request to assert certified irrigator status if the Director finds that the information provided by the applicant is incorrect or incomplete.
- (D) AWU Authorized Irrigation Inspector status shall be considered valid for a period of 3 years from the date of authorization, provided the Licensed Irrigation Inspector maintains licensing with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
- (E) Renewal of AWU Authorized Irrigation Inspector status will require the submittal of a new application along with documentation of a current Irrigation Inspector license from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and documentation of successful completion of the Director-approved landscape irrigation course within the preceding six (6) months.
- (F) A list of AWU Authorized Irrigation Inspectors will be maintained by Austin Water and may be posted on the Austin Water Utility website or otherwise made available by Austin Water Utility.
- (G) An AWU Authorized Irrigation Inspector status awarded by the Director may be revoked by the Director upon official determination of any violation of state irrigator licensing requirements as set forth in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code Chapter 344, Rules for Landscape Irrigation.
- (H) An AWU Authorized Irrigation Inspector status awarded by the Director may be terminated at any time upon request by the applicant.

The authority and procedure for adoption of a rule to assist in the implementation, administration, or enforcement of a provision of the City Code is provided in Chapter 1-2 of the City Code. The authority to regulate the water use is established in Texas Local Government Code Section 552.001 and Title 6 of Austin City Code.
