REGULAR MEETING MINUTES MONDAY, September 10, 2012

The Art in Public Places Panel convened in a regular meeting on *Monday, September 10, 2012* at City Hall, Room 2016, 301 W. 2nd Street, Austin, Texas

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

4. ARTS COMMISSION LIAISON REPORT

Panel Member Daigle reported that the Arts Commission approved the AIPP items that were on the 8/20/12 agenda and provided an update on the development of a City-wide donation policy.

6. NEW BUSINESS

a. Mid-Design Review for 2nd Street Bridge and Extension AIPP Project -- Sharon Engelstein, Artist

Susan Lambe provided an update on the status of the project. Sharon Engelstein then reviewed her design for artwork which includes a large-scale, free-standing abstract sculpture located adjacent to the 2nd Street Bridge.

b. Mid-Design Review for Lady Bird Lake Boardwalk Trail AIPP Project -- Art Guys, Artists

Jean Graham provided an update on the status of the project. The Art Guys presented an update on the mid-designs from artists Ken Little, Gary Sweeney and Anthony Thompson Shumate. "Belting it Out," by Ken Little, consists of several traditional Western belts cast in bronze that incorporate song lyrics in

English and Braille. Six ceramic enameled signs, by Gary Sweeney, will be placed in select resting areas intended to provide visitors with humorous twist on informational signage. And finally, "Cursor," by Anthony Thompson Shumate, will feature a series of powder coated steel sculptures made to look like a computer cursor placed in scenic locations along the boardwalk.

c. Discussion and Possible Action for Artist Selection Process for Deep Eddy Pool AIPP Project

Jean Graham proposed using the remaining AIPP funds associated with the Deep Eddy Pool CIP project for a performance-based project to occur at the pool. The opportunity would also include a video/recording documentation of the event that could be played at the pool on a regular basis.

Meghan Turner provided an update on the temporary public art program, including several parks that would be well suited for temporary installations, as proposed by Panel Member Frank. Ms. Turner stated that she would present an updated Call to Artists at the October 1, 2012 Panel meeting.
