Geographic Area Review

c4 A review of the geographic areas will be conducted every five (5) years utilizing the results of the Community Needs Assessment. HHSD will submit a recommendation to the CDC if the results of the analysis indicate a geographic area should be changed to more effectively further the purposes of the CSBC program.

Responsible Organization Review

- c4 An annual review of the responsible organizations using established criteria will be conducted to determine whither the organization is actively representing the residents of the respective geographic area.
- ca HHSD will submit a recommendation to the CDC for removal or replacement of an organization if the results of the review indicates noncompliance with the established criteria OR if the organization wishes to discontinue the role of "naportable organization"

If recommended changes are approved, the CDC will forward a recommendation to the City Council for amendment of the ordinance.
