**Additional Backup Information**

Austin Transportation Department staff initiated the stakeholder outreach process in late 2012 to continue discussions on the pedicab ordinance adopted by Council on April 12, 2012.

The pedicab stakeholders recommended a requirement that all tow-bikes associated with trailer-type pedicabs secure an annual safety inspection from a third-party provider. Staff agrees with this recommendation and also recommends this requirement be aligned with the braking system requirement and become effective July 1, 2013. In preparation of this inspection requirement, staff will begin the process of identifying potential providers qualified to conduct bicycle inspections.
