This project will construct a new trail on the Walnut Creek Greenbelt to connect Balcones Park to Walnut Creek Metro Park through the greenbelt. The trail will be approximately three miles long and consist of a ten foot wide concrete trail, two foot wide shoulders, nine creek crossings by bridge or culvert, and two trailheads.

The project team has met with the affected neighborhoods and will provide ongoing communication with all property owners who will potentially be affected by the construction. Communication with these groups will continue throughout the construction phase.

Due to the potential for unknown subsurface conditions and utility conflicts when working in the right of way, a 5% contingency in funding has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any change orders. The contract allows 365 calendar days for completion of the project. Construction is anticipated to start in February 2013 and continue until February 2014. This project is located within zip codes 78759 and 78758 and is managed by the Public Works Department.

Muniz Concrete & Contracting, Inc. is located in Austin, Texas.
