Additional Backup Information	

With the selection of Michael Van Valkenburg and Associates (MVVA) as the winner of the Waller Creek Conservancy Design Competition, the City has an opportunity to coordinate with MVVA in evaluating possibilities for modification of the ongoing Waller Creek Tunnel Program projects to accommodate aspects of the MVVA design. The Public Works Department (PW) proposes to contract with KBR/RPS Espey Joint Venture (JV) to coordinate the Waller Creek Tunnel Program with the Waller Creek Conservancy Design. The Contract Management Department has approved PW's request to exempt this contract from the City's professional services solicitation requirements due to the consultant's demonstrated expertise and in-depth knowledge of the existing design and construction project at Waller Creek. JV is the design engineer for the Waller Creek Tunnel projects, and is currently providing construction management services for the ongoing projects. Thus, they are uniquely qualified to evaluate coordination opportunities in regards to design.

The initial contract with JV will cover coordination and scoping activities, focused on identifying and describing potential opportunities for modifications. The estimated value of this phase of the contract is \$250,000. If opportunities for changes are identified and approved, Public Works will seek additional Council authorization to amend the JV contract to provide engineering design services for those changes. No subconsultant participation is anticipated for the preliminary phase of the work, although subconsultants may be used for the design phase if modifications are approved.

This project is managed by the Public Works Department.
