**ANALYSIS** / **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**: Approval of this budget amendment to reallocate a total of \$2,601,455 in existing funding will allow the Department to adequately fund Northern Walnut Creek Trail project. Per Council approved Financial Policies, the Financial Services Department maintains a CIP Contingency Reserve to supplement project budgets.

This appropriation will be utilized for the construction of an approximately 3 mile long trail on the Walnut Creek Greenbelt to connect Balcones Park to the Walnut Creek Metropolitan Park. It will consist of a ten foot wide concrete trail, two foot shoulders, approximately nine creek crossings by bridge or culvert crossing, and two trailheads.
