AN ORDINANCE REZONING AND CHANGING THE ZONING MAP FOR THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 1123 EAST 11<sup>TH</sup> STREET IN THE CENTRAL EAST AUSTIN NEIGHBORHOOD PLAN AREA FROM COMMERCIAL LIQUOR SALES-NEIGHBORHOOD CONSERVATION **COMBINING DISTRICT-**NEIGHBORHOOD PLAN (CS-1-NCCD-NP) COMB NING DISTRICT COMMERCIAL SALES-NEIGHBORHOOD LIOUOR **CONSERVATION COMBINING** DISTRICT-NEIGHBORHOOD PLAN (CS-1-NCCD-NP) COMBINING DISTRICT.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The zoning map established by Section 25-2-19 of the City Code is amended to change the base district from commercial liquor sales-neighborhood conservation combining district-neighborhood plan (CS-1-NCCD-NP) combining district to commercial liquor sales-neighborhood conservation combining district neighborhood plan (CS-1-NCCD-NP) combining district on the property described in Zoning Case No. C14-2012-0123, on file at the Planning and Development Review Department, as follows:

Lot 5, Block 7, Outlo 2-3, Division B, George L. Robertson Subdivision, a subdivision in the City of Austin, Travis County, Texas, according to the map or plat of record in Plat Book 1, Page 4 of the Plat Records of Travis County, Texas (the "Property"),

locally known as 1123 East 1 th Street in the City of Austin, Travis County, Texas, and generally identified in the map attac ed as Exhibit "A".

PART 2. Except as specifically provided in Part 3 and Part 4 of this ordinance, the Property may be developed and used in accordance with the regulations established for the commercial liquor sales (CS-1) base district and other applicable requirements of the City Code.

**PART 3.** The Property within the boundaries of the conditional overlay combining district established by this ordinance is subject to the following conditions:
