<u>Initial Determination</u>: Based on a review of the City records and written and oral testimony presented to staff, good cause does exist to make the initial determination that a prevailing wage violation occurred on the project and the following workers are owed back wages:

- a. <u>Prime Contractor</u>: Barecky Construction Company
- b. Subcontractor: Bomax Contractors LLC
- c. <u>Allegation</u>: The complaint received alleges that four individuals were employed on this project by Bomax and were paid below the prevailing wage for performing Carpentry work.
- d. <u>Findings</u>: The workers identified above were paid less than the prevailing wage for work performed for a portion of the time worked on the project. We are unable to provide a specific dollar amount due to insufficient documentation.
