- 1. CALL TO ORDER Peter Shen, Chair called meeting to order 6:20pm.

A. Secured Communities Program – James Kuhr – summary on issues that immigrants face when arrested such as: lack of I.D. Suggestions made by the board - public meetings to educate the immigrants - information leaflet on "what to do to avoid arrest" and the "advantages of carrying an I.D.". Further discussion needed.

A. Emergency Card Update – Donald Krupens gave summary on project explaining the purpose of the cards. James Kuhr - a public announcement possibly at the City Hall. Angela Touza-Medina – cards could be distributed at community international events. Further discussion needed.
