- SMI is the largest glass processor in North America and one of the top 10 independent plastics processors.
- Strategic Materials sells approximately 2.5 million tons of glass cullet each year. Primary markets include the glass container, fiberglass, and specialty glass markets.
- Strategic Materials has an outstanding reputation in terms of product quality, customer service and integrity.
- We collect scrap glass from a diverse range of sources, extending from residential collection programs to recycling drop-off centers, container and plate glass manufacturers.

Midlothian Plant:

- Our plant, located at 3240 Robinson Road in Midlothian, TX is capable of processing over seventy-five thousand tons of glass per year.
- The plant uses advanced sortation methods to clean, grind, and separate the glass into furnace-ready glass cullet
- Currently the plant has 25 full-time employees and in 2010 paid approximately \$150,000 in taxes
- From this location we provide glass cullet to virtually all of the fiberglass and glass container plants in Texas, Oklahoma, and Louisiana

Facts About Glass:

- Glass recycles at 100% and can be recycled endlessly.
- For every 6 tons of recycled glass used, 1 ton of CO₂ emissions are reduced.
- Recycling just 10 glass containers per week saves enough energy to power a computer for 5 hours
