Approve a resolution for a conditional commitment of a loan in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000 to 2007 Travis Heights, LP, an affiliate of Eureka Holdings, Inc., for the proposed demolition of existing structures and the new construction of 170 units located at 2324 Wilson Street, with funding being conditional upon the award of tax credits to 2007 Travis Heights, LP by the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs for the proposed project.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding is contingent upon award of Housing Tax Credits.

Additional Backup Information

If approved, the resolution will be submitted by 2007 Travis Heights, LP along with its Low Income Housing Tax Credit application to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA). Applications that have a commitment of funding from a unit of local government, even if the commitment is conditioned upon the award of tax credits, will qualify for a certain number of points in this competitive process.

As of January 11, 2013, 18 “pre-applications” were submitted from Austin and other cities in Hays and Williamson Counties requesting a total of \$24 million in tax credits. TDHCA has \$3.3 million in tax credits allocated to Texas Region 7, which includes Austin and surrounding counties. Out of the 18 pre-applications, it is likely that only one or two projects can be funded with \$3.3 million in tax credits. The maximum tax credit award per project is \$1.5 million.

Full applications are due to TDHCA on March 1, 2013 and the announcement of tax credit awards will likely be in June or July of 2013.
