PROJECT SUMMARY:

This Request for Council Action is in response to Council Resolution No. 20120816-061 to develop a consistent and efficient artwork donation policy in collaboration with the Austin Arts Commission that would enable the City to respond to artwork donations or loan requests in a centralized way. The current Artwork Donation and Loan Policy has been in place since 1985.

Economic Growth and Redevelopment Services Office (EGRSO) staff led 4 meetings to determine revisions to the donation and loan policy. The following departments participated: Parks and Recreation Department, Austin Bergstrom International Airport, Austin Public Library, Austin Police Department, Austin Fire Department, Public Works, Austin Transportation Department, Austin Convention Center, Austin Energy, and Planning, Development and Review Department. A representative from the Austin Arts Commission served as liaison to the departmental working group. The Arts Commission has approved the revisions to Artwork Donation and Loan Policy.

The process of revisions to the policy resulted in a department-wide consensus on the need and intent of a policy. The recommended policy revisions will allow for a refined process for coordinated reviews and improved customer service. In addition, recommended changes will result in a citywide collection management organizational structure to ensure proper recordkeeping and maintenance of the City's cultural assets.
