Additional Backup Information						
In September 2011, the Planning Commission initiated a code amendment related to bicycle parking requirements. After significant review consistent with the bicycle parking best practice recommendations made by the 2007 Street Smarts Task Force, the Bicycle Master Plan, and the Bicycle Advisory Council, the Bicycle Program staff identified ten potential amendments to the City Code. The proposed staff recommendation is coordinated with the ongoing proposed Subchapter E, downtown motor vehicle parking requirement amendments, and through the lens of the future Land Development Code rewrite that could further refine these recommendations. Presentations were provided to the Downtown Commission, the Design Commission, and the Urban Transportation Commission. Staff recommends approval of this amendment.
