Additional Backup Information

The City of Austin annexed an area of Williamson County along a portion of Pond Springs Road adjacent to US 183 after Williamson County voters had already approved bond funding for improvements in that area. On March 27, 2009, Williamson County and the City of Austin entered into an interlocal agreement in which the County agreed to manage those improvements and contribute up to \$6,000,000, and the City agreed to contribute up to \$500,000.

After construction was complete, a property owner submitted a claim against the City for flooding damages to his property during major rainfall events at 13216 Pond Springs Road. Williamson County investigated the claim, analyzed the drainage conditions, and agreed to be responsible in this second amendment for any flooding damage to the property in question caused by the improvements to Pond Springs Road.
