This amendment was initiated by the Planning Commission.

The amendment proposes an adjustment of a portion of the existing boundary line between the Butler Shores Subdistrict and the Auditorium Shores Subdistrict of the Waterfront Overlay. Discussion of this adjustment centers on a commercial property located at 1210 Barton Springs Drive (Jack and Adam's Bicycle Shop), which is the only commercial property in the area that falls within the secondary setback of the Auditorium Shores Subdistrict, and as a result is the only commercial property in the area with restricted allowable uses. Moving the boundary between the Auditorium Shores Subdistrict to the Butler Shores Subdistrict such that the above described property, as well as two adjacent properties (1209 and 1215 Barton Springs Road), fall into the Butler Shores Subdistrict would ensure that adjacent commercial properties are being treated in a similar fashion, subject to the same regulations, and allow the property at 1210 Barton Springs Road to have allowable uses per the base zoning district of the property, as is the case currently with adjacent commercial properties.

Staff recommends approval of this amendment.
