

## **RESOLUTION NO.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council approved Resolution No. 20110623-091 authorizing the City Manager to negotiate and execute an Agreement with the Austin Parks Foundation (“APF”) to allow for a concessionaire to sell food at the Old Bakery store at 1006 Congress Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, the resolution, in part, described the types of food to be sold to include “coffee and baked goods, prepackaged snack and food items, and canned non-alcoholic beverages;” and

**WHEREAS**, the agreement between the City and APF has expired and a new agreement is proposed; and

**WHEREAS**, APF has contracted with new concessionaires that would provide a variety of foods other than just prepackaged items; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties wish to clarify the types of foods that may be prepared on the property and sold to the public; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

### **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

Resolution No. 20110623-091 is amended to clarify that any reference to the sale of food and beverages sold under a concession agreement executed between the City and APF may include, but is not limited to coffee and baked goods, prepackaged snack and food items, fresh food prepared on-site and canned non-alcoholic beverages.
