Additional Backup Information

This amendment was initiated by the Planning Commission.

Certain properties are currently prohibited from applying for temporary permits for outdoor events, depending on the zoning of the property. The proposed amendment would allow a property whose principal developed use is religious assembly, private primary educational facilities, private secondary educational facilities, public primary educational facilities, public secondary facilities, or public community recreation, to apply for temporary use permit for outdoor assembly, regardless of zoning district.

Staff recommends approval of this amendment.
