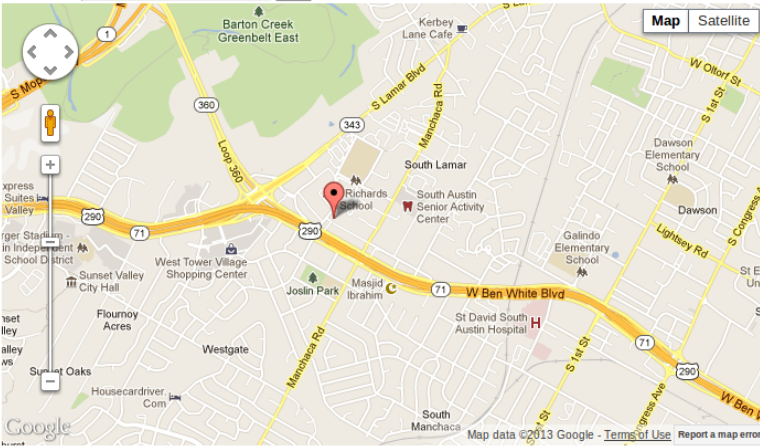

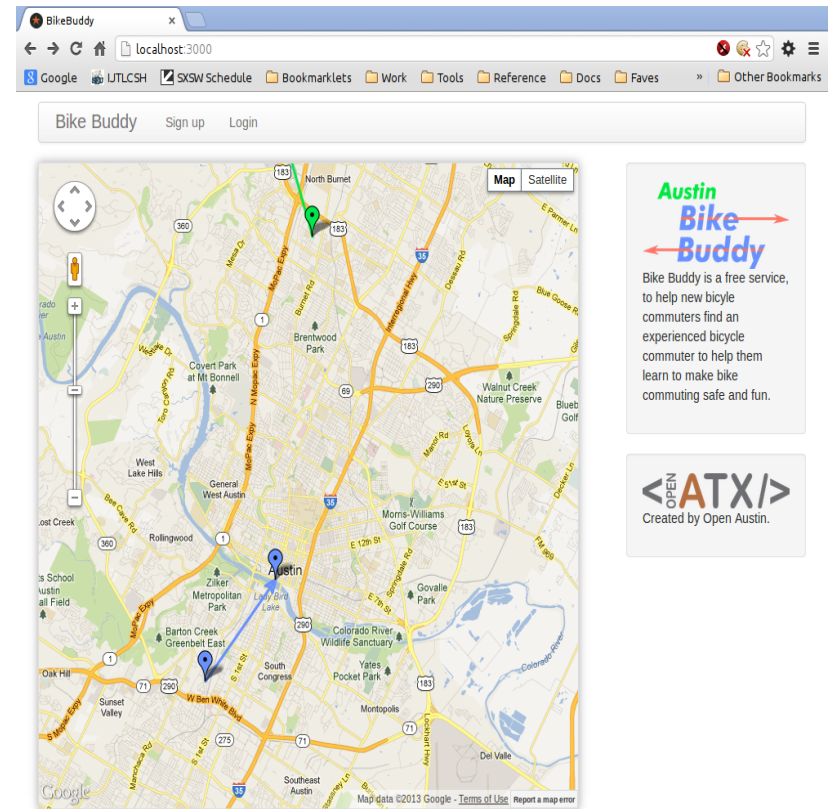

Office of Civic Tech Innovation

- Open Austin presented proposal for an Office of Civic Technology Innovation, Aug 30, 2012 budget hearing
- Council approved \$250K in FY2013 budget as seed funding to support two FTEs and programs
- Currently awaiting implementation
- Concerns:
 - Depth of community engagement during planning
 - Delays resulting in stagnation and resource issues with civic tech initiatives
