ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The City of Austin purchased the current Betty Dunkerley campus, located at 7201 Levander Loop, for the Health and Human Services Department (HHSD) in 2000. The campus infrastructure was built in the 1960s and has since deteriorated. Some of the buildings were renovated and are used by the HHSD. Jackson and Ryan Architects (JRA) were selected to provide professional services for the Animal Services Center project on the south side of the campus. Due to cost, some overall campus utilities and infrastructure upgrades were deleted from the scope of the Animal Service Center project. The 2012 Bond Program includes funding to address these upgrades.
