Install a metal longhorn sculpture in the front yard.

PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS

The sculpture, which is already there, is a steel outdoor sculpture, created by Frederick Prescott. It is 10 feet high, 18 feet wide, and 20 inches deep, and painted burnt orange. It is set in a small bed in the front yard of the house.

STANDARDS FOR REVIEW

The Commission's Standards for Review of applications for Certificates of Appropriateness do not incorporate any landscape features.
